

pc.easynet help - transfers via pc.easynet


Transact – Credit External

When transferring to an external account via pc.easynet, you need a BSB, account number and the name on the account at the other end. If you don't follow the steps below it may display a message such as "Account name has invalid characters".

BSB Number has to be 6 digits.

Account Number can be no longer than 9 digits.

In Name Of should just be surname and initials, no punctuation (full stops, commas) or symbols (&). If a joint account, use the word *AND*.


